- It can legally contain less than 25% actual meat and the other 75% is just chemical fillers.
- Even products that are advertised as natural containing no chemicals or preservatives usually always does, because there is a loophole that allows them to use products already containing chemicals as long as they do not add more in the production process.
- The chemicals and preservatives used are scientifically proven to cause many diseases including cancer, organ dysfunction, organ failure, congenital disabilities, hair loss and behavior problems.
- The chemicals and preservatives used are scientifically proven to reduce the lifespan of your dog significantly.

Studies have shown that dogs can live as long as 27 years, however with because of commercial dog food the average life expectancy for a dog is sadly only 11 years.

• The meat used in dog food is not regulated like meat used for people; it can legally contain road kill, our euthanized pets that have died at the vet, euthanized zoo animals, and diseased farm animals that have died.
